

Kids' Activities - Thursday Holy Week

Theme: Holy Spirit

John 14:15-27

1. Watch the following video:

2. Discuss the following with your kids:

Why can't you see the Holy Spirit on an X-ray?

The Holy Spirit is in us and with us. What does he do for us?

Even though we can't see him on an X-ray, He's there guiding us, teaching us, and comforting us!

1. Print out that paper and cut out the house. The kids can decorate the outside of the house with the things that the Holy Spirit has given them. (this can be family, friends, talents, things that they like).
2. Fold the edges and tape them to make the house 3-dimensional.
3. Place a battery-operated tea light inside the house. This represents the Holy Spirit living inside of us!
